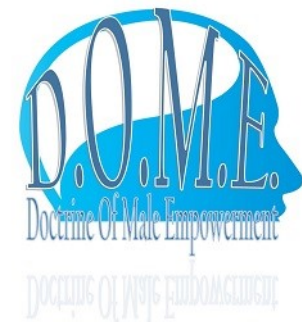

OUR D.O.M.E. MISSION...

To encourage young men to become gentlemen, to better identify positive role models and to become the positive change in their community. To assist in the understanding that education is the hammer that breaks down walls, that confine them.

WHY D.O.M.E.?

The Doctrine Of Male Empowerment (D.O.M.E.)

Program's goal is to provide young men with the tools to enter the world unfazed by negative stereotypes. To understand the use and purpose of code switching to enable them to chip away at the barriers they perceive as keeping them back, both from fear of failure and fear of success.

There are steps to achieving your goals and dreams let us help...

D.O.M.E. is a place where **young men learn that they can be successful gentlemen**, a place where collaboration and business development are fostered through encouragement and community service, to release the possibility within D.O.M.E. is delivered in three phases:

1. Mentoring/D.O.M.E. Partner

Each member of the program is provided with a D.O.M.E. Partner who serves as his mentor and empowerment guide. The D.O.M.E. Partner is responsible for setting and assisting their mentee in obtaining "Goal Nuggets." These "Goal Nuggets," are the supporting blocks of the D.O.M.E. member's future. Each "Goal Nugget" represents a hope, dream or accomplishment waiting to be achieved. For this, each D.O.M.E. members are given tools to help them document the steps to reaching their

dreams.

2. D.O.M.E. Group

Each week the D.O.M.E. members are invited to a group to participate in discussions about relevant topics related to young men, growth and empowerment. The Happy Family developed curriculum, reflects topics that rotate on a 16 week cycle, with periodic topic refreshes to remain current.



This is a therapeutic group meant to allow D.O.M.E. members to voice their opinion and obtain advice. It is the responsibility of the members to ensure attendance (80% attendance is needed for graduation).

3. D.O.M.E. Activity/Graduation

Each group cycle D.O.M.E. members participate in group activities and graduation. Each activity incorporates empowerment, team work and strength building. Though every member may not be a leader of many, they will be a leader of self!

Our staff are trained in verbal de-escalation, driver safety, community engagement, CPR and First aid and a host of other therapeutic trainings .
