Supervised Visitation

During a Supervised Visitation Happy Family Staff is responsible for making sure the family has positive interactions, however our primary role is to ensure that the child/children are protected from physical, mental or emotional harm during the visit.

We provide each parent, custodial and noncustodial, with a copy of our Rules of Engagement and our Safety and Security protocols, which detail how we expect the visit to be conducted. Parents are encouraged to:

- Show children affection – Tell them you love them, and how much you miss them
- Be positive
- Be Loving
- Show you care
- Parent

Parents are instructed not to make empty

promises, sneak things, or use inappropriate language, as they are seen as injurious and inhibit the positive atmosphere of the visit and are grounds for visit termination.

Exchange Services

Happy Family also serves as a neutral exchange location. Exchanges are implemented when parents are not required to have supervised visitation with their children but need a mediator to assist in the “handoff” from one parent to the other. Exchanges can be done with involvement from both parents or without interaction. The exchanges are monitored to safeguard against a confrontational exchange.

Visit Coaching

Utilizing the Visit Coaching Model, developed by Marty Beyer, supervised visits are transformed into **Therapeutic Family Time**. The tools and use of this program model is reunification with a start to close time line of 3 months or less. The differences between traditional supervised visitation and visit coaching is that the case supervisor is a constant part of the visit, rather than an objective observer.
